

Nathaniel Mantiply, and removed very soon to Ky., probably because the land he received for his military service in 1759 & '60 lay there.

His daughter, Elizabeth^s, married in Amherst Nov. 1, 1784, Joshua Hudson, Jr., and it was this marriage that identified him absolutely. Linn⁴ Banks died in Garrard Co., Ky. His will, dated Dec. 27, 1799, but with no date of probate, is given in Mrs. McAdams's Ky. Pioneer and Court Records, p. 39. In it he mentions wife Sarah, children Leanna^s Pollard, Sarah^s Poindexter, Lucy^s Marksberry, Mary^s Mayfield, John^s Banks, Cerina^s Taylor, Susannah^s Nanks, Nancy^s Wilson, grandson Arasha^s (Horatio) Hudson, dau. Sophia^s, grandson Linn⁶ Banks, son of son Wm.^s Banks. Exors.: Wm.^s, John^s and Gerard^s Banks. With reference to Elizabeth^s Banks, we have seen that she married in Amherst Co. Joshua Hudson, Jr. He d. 1793, for in that year his father, Joshua Hudson, Sr., obtained administration on his estate. (Amherst records, W. B. 3, p. 277). Joshua Hudson, Jr., and Elizabeth^s Banks presumably had only two children, for Joshua Hudson in his will, dated Feb. 5, 1799, (Amherst W. B. 4, p. 6) makes a bequest to "Horatio^s and Nancy^s, infant children of my son Joshua Hudson". A codicil, dated Nov. 9, 1800, notes that he has paid to Horatio^s and Nancy^s, orphans of Joshua Hudson decd." the part of their father's estate that was in his hands. In passing, the remark may be made that Joshua Hudson probably belonged to the Westmoreland family of that name, among whom the names Rush and Joshua were frequent.

Coming back to the other children of Linn⁴ and Sarah Banks, we notice the names dau. Leanna^s Pollard. In the list of Revolutionary Pensioners for 1840, she is listed as living in Garrard Co., Ky., aged 63, hence b. 1777.

On page 43 of this same book is given the will of Sam'l. Marksberry, dated Dec. 29, 1812, probated July —, 1813, in which he mentions daus. Rachel and Jane Banks. Saml. Marksberry had gone to Ky. from Amherst Co. being probably the person referred to in the following deed: Amherst records, D. B. A, p. 233, July 2, 1764, Sam'l. Marksberry of Amherst to Zachariah Talliaferro of the same county 400 a. "all that land granted Saml. Marksberry by a deed dated Sept. 18, 1739, from Jas. Churchill to Sam'l. Marksberry the elder, part of 1500 a. granted sd. Churchill Feb. 1, 1738, and which
