

In the name of God Amen this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty four, I Phebe Barratt being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same calling to mind that it is appointed one for all men to die I do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament First I give my soul who gave it me and my body to the earth to be buried after a christain like manner I will and bequeath in manner and form as followeth first I will and bequeath to my son George Barratt a book called practice of piety I will and bequeath to my son Matthew Barratt a bible book to be left to the care of George Green till they come at age I will and bequeath to my son John Barratt a young horse two years old with a blaze in his face. I will and bequeath to my daughter Phebe Barratt a pido cow known by the name of lady and a pewter dish I will and bequeath to my son Moses Barratt a cow called damsell I will and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Brown a iron pot which she has now in keeping and a black sow. I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary Barratt a cow called white face and her calf and a brown mare called fancy and a feather bed and furniture thereto belonging and all the feathers that is in a tub that stands in James Brown's house and a chest and a big pewter dish and four plates two iron potts and pot hooks and all the rest of my estate to be equally divide between my son William Barratt and Mary Barratt if ever my son Humphrey Barratt comes back here I will and bequeath him twenty shillings and I leave my son William Barratt and my daughter Mary Barratt to be my whole and sole executors disannulling all other wills acknowledging this to be my last will and testament
